A top-scoring wine since its debut in 1998, our 2004 Sonoma Chardonnay from Dutton Ranch vineyards is balanced, crisp and delicious. Crafted from mature, low-yielding Russian River vines, the wine has a distinctive nose of jasmine and orange blossom, with custard and vanilla bean aromas. Framed in toasty oak and loaded with ripe citrus fruit flavors, the wine is balanced, rich, and refreshing, with trademark Meyer lemon zest on the finish.

“Lewis has won its fair share of accolades in these pages over the years, and this head-turning Chardonnay only adds to its many successes. Led by lots of concentrated, keenly focused varietal fruit, the wine is enriched with complementary oak and shows touches of stony terroir. It is fairly full and fleshy in feel as is the winery’s style, but it is also uncommonly well-balanced and very lively throughout. Its one fault is that it may still be too young to really show all that it has, and it comes with high praise and a caution against drinking too soon.”
